 Monday, October 19, 2009**

The Board of Glacier County Commissioners met at a regular meeting at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 19th, 2009. Commissioners Michael DesRosier, Ron Rides At The Door and Tony Sitzmann were present. Commissioner Michael DesRosier called the meeting to order. Glenda Hall, Clerk & Recorder was present.

9:00 a.m. Approval- Consolidated Office Resolution 2009-14

The Commissioners decided to postpone the approval of the consolidated office until such time that they can meet with the administration and School Board District #9, to address concerns, since they were unable to attend the public hearing on October 16th, 2009, as they were all in attendance at a professional development workshop in Missoula.

9:30 a.m. Approval-Request for Proposal-Road Building- East Glacier

The commissioners received one proposal for the Road Building in East Glacier from Circle R Construction. The bid meets all of the specifications of the building requested. Circle R Construction would like a five year contract at \$998 per month. Commissioners will have County Attorney, Larry Epstein, draw up a contract for the proposal. The building would provide security and outdoor storage, and relieve pressure on space shortage for the East Glacier Fire Department. EGFD will be responsible for the upkeep and utilities on the property.
