REGULAR MEETING
Monday, October 18, 2010**

The Board of Glacier County Commissioners met at a regular meeting at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, October 18, 2010. Commissioners Ron Rides At The Door and Tony Sitzmann were present. Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door called the meeting to order. Glenda Hall, Clerk & Recorder was present.

11:00 a.m. Discussion/Approval: Membership Position for Aging

Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door motioned to approve the position switch from Commissioner Rides At The Door to Commissioner Tony Sitzmann to be on the governing board for North Central Area on Aging. Commissioner Tony Sitzmann seconds the motion, the motion carried.

11:15 a.m. Non-Agenda Item: Jerilee Wilkerson, Economic Development Director

Glacier County's new economic development director, Jerilee Wilkerson briefly reviewed topics of interest from a training for the Glacier County Transit last week. Wilkerson would like to see Glacier County Transit on the web. Commissioner Rides At The Door also thinks that utilizing the web is an effective, low cost way to get the word about for the semi-new locally ran transit system (Glacier County Transit). Wilkerson asked if the transit information could be added to the county's website. Commissioner Rides At The Door replied that there was a link that would work for the transit webpage.

Wilkerson would like to expand the advertising for Glacier County Transit. The goal across the state for public transportation is to get the word out, pick up ridership and get the public to realize that the transit system is public, not limited to senior citizens. Wilkerson is going to use the face of the bus to advertise. Wilkerson informed the commission of discussion about becoming a regional transit system with surrounding transit systems, with intentions to share a dispatcher and possibly hire an additional bus driver.

The commissioners reviewed the minutes. Commissioner Tony Sitzmann motioned to approve the minutes from 10/14/10. Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door seconds the motion, the motion then carried.
