8:30 a.m. Approval of Minutes

The commission reviewed the July 2010 reports presented by Sheriff Dusterhoff. The commission accepted the Sheriff's Departments July 2010 reports as presented.

10:00 a.m. Discussion/Approval: Glacier County Website

The commissioners reviewed the claim from Morris & Maierle in the amount of \$47.50 for web design: specifically updating the web page for the Glacier County Health Department. Commissioner Rides At The Door stated that he would be in contact with Morris & Maierle to hold a training for every department head to educate them on updating their departments web page. This will save money rather than paying Morris & Maierle for work the department head is capable of handling. The web design training has been offered in the past with no department heads attending. This may be a requirement or mandatory training for the department head.

Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door motioned to approve the payment of \$47.50 to Morris & Maierle for web design for the Health Department. Commissioner Tony Sitzmann seconds the motion, the motion carried.

Commissioner DesRosier stated that today the combat operations in Iraq have ended after seven and a half (7.5) years.
