

**GLACIER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**  
**Town of Browning City Hall**  
**Tuesday, August 23, 2011**

The Board of Glacier County Commissioners met at a regular meeting at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 23, 2011. Commissioners Michael DesRosier & Ron Rides At The Door were present. Commissioner Michael DesRosier called the meeting to order. Commissioner Tony Sitzmann was absent in order to attend a Sweetgrass Development meeting in Great Falls. Clerk & Recorder Glenda Hall was absent; at the office working on the budget.

**10:00 a.m. City/County/Tribe Summit**

Mayor Lockley Bremner was not present for the summit meeting; his wife had a baby this morning. With no representatives from the Town of Browning and the Blackfeet Tribe the Commissioners had small talk with John McGill of the Glacier Reporter.

**10:55 a.m. Non-Agenda Item: Nora Kennedy**

Nora Kennedy delivered the residence and mapping for the Blackfeet Reservation. Both Commissioners DesRosier & Rides At The Door discussed briefly with Kennedy signage for all county, state and tribal roads. The county and the tribe would like to work together in order to tackle a project of this nature.

**11:00 a.m. Discussion/Approval: Mutual Aid Agreement Contingency Staffing for Glacier County Health Department & Sanitarian**

Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door explained the contents of the mutual aid agreement between Glacier, Pondera, Teton & Toole Counties. This commits county resources in case of an emergency. It does not include contract services, only available resources. Resources may include available employees, vaccinations, medications, etc. Commissioner DesRosier added that this agreement is similar to a MOU (memorandum of understanding). John McGill needed clarification that this would or would not include Glacier County's sanitarian. Commissioner DesRosier replied no, that Ron Anderson is under contract with Glacier County. Commissioner Rides At The Door continued that this agreement would only be acted upon in a case of an extreme disaster (ex: tornado within one of the four counties included in the MOU).

Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door motioned to approve the Mutual Aid Agreement Contingency Staffing for Glacier County Health Department and Sanitarian which includes Glacier, Pondera, Teton & Toole Counties. Commissioner Michael J. DesRosier seconds the motion, the motion carried.

There being no further business for the day, the meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m. with a motion by Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door and a second by Commissioner Michael J. DesRosier. The motion passed by Board vote.
