9:00 a.m. Discussion/Approval: Community Service Coordinator

Clerk of Court Diane Anderson explained to the commission that the Community Service Coordinator (CSC) recently resigned to take a full-time job. We would like approval to advertise to fill this vacant position. Commissioner Tony Sitzmann motioned to approve the advertising for the Community Service Coordinator immediately. With no further discussion necessary, Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door second the motion, the motion carried with a unanimous vote.

9:30 a.m. Discussion/Approval: House Arrest Grant for Juveniles

Tasha Stiner, Chief Probation Officer described the grant thru the Board of Crime Control for house arrest for juveniles. The grant is for the amount of \$170k. The house arrest monitoring bracelets will help with GPS and alcohol monitoring. This again is strictly for juveniles. Stiner is the Chief Probation Officer for Glacier, Toole, Pondera & Teton Counties. Stiner chose Glacier County as the county to manage the funds. This will help save Glacier County funds. Stiner explained further that Glacier County will be the “pass thru” so there will not be a procurement process. Commissioner Rides At The Door asked if the funds will be used quickly. Stiner replied that the funds will be used and the funds are use it or lose it according to the grant terms. Commissioner Sitzmann asked if this was replacing the option of sending the juvenile to

a nearby detention center. Stiner replied, yes and Great Falls is the nearest detention center. The cost for sending a juvenile to the Great Falls Detention Center is \$112 per day. Stiner presented the commissioners with an MOU to review for these specific juvenile services. Commissioner Tony Sitzmann motioned to approve the MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) between the Office of Court Administration & Glacier County for the GPS & Alcohol Monitoring Services. Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door seconds the motion. The motion carried without any further discussion.

*Commissioner Tony Sitzmann left the chambers for the remainder of the day in order to attend the RC&D Board Meeting in Shelby.

10:00 a.m. Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Ron Rides At The Door motioned to approve the minutes from 4/5/11, 4/11/11, 4/14/11 & 4/18/11. Commissioner Michael DesRosier seconds the motion, the motion carried.
