The Glacier County Board of Commissioners met at a regular scheduled meeting at 9:00 am Tuesday, March 23, 2021. Commissioners Mary Jo Bremner and Michael J. DesRosier was present. Commissioner Overcast was absent-medical. Commissioner Bremner was taking minutes.

She would like to report that Senator Tester’s Office did reply right away and we are hoping that funds with the ARPA Rescue Plan can help assist in this purchase and they will let her know when they find out. Senator Tester’s office has contacted her a few times since the initial phone call. MACo has not replied at this time. Marty Woolf, West End Cemetery Sexton is present to talk about his resignation at West End Cemetery. He states that he would like his resignation to be immediate and did not wish to provide his two-week notice. He states to the commissioners his frustration on the lack of help on his end and he has worked at the cemetery for over 25 years. The Commissioners thanked him for his service. The Commissioners asked if his assistant can step in and take his duties until they can find a person to replace his position. Marty assured them that he could and he will talk to him. The Commissioners state that they will start their search asap. The Commissioners told Marty that they honor his decision and that he could be done without his two-week notice. Marty excused himself from the meeting. Commissioner Bremner & DesRosier expressed the need to replace a board member as there is a vacancy.
