The Glacier County Board of Commissioners met at a regular scheduled meeting at 9:00 a.m., Tuesday, February 28, 2023. Commissioners Mary Jo Bremner, Vernon “Napi” Billedeaux and John B. Overcast was present.

C. Discussion: Public Hearing #1 Lease of Glacier County Care Center - Mike Kittson, Human Resources Director/Glacier County Commissioners

D. Discussion/Approval: Service Vehicle Repairs (\$10,649.18) – John “Snoop” Evans, Glacier County Road Department Supervisor

John “Snoop” Evans, Glacier County Road Supervisor is present for this item. He explains to the commissioners that one of their many aging vehicles in the road department is in need of repair in the amount of \$10,649.18. Although this is a huge cost to the department it is a needed one as it’s less expensive to repair a fleet vehicle at this point. It is decided that the commissioners will agree to the repair.
