The Glacier County Board of Commissioners met at a regularly scheduled meeting at 9:00 a.m., Tuesday, January 9, 2024. Commissioners Vernon “Napi” Billedeaux and John B. Overcast were present. Commissioner Mary Jo Bremner was out-of-country.

**C. Discussion/Approval: Lexipol – Police One Academy Annual Subscription Agreement – Tom Seifert, Glacier County Undersheriff/Glacier County Commissioners**

Tome Seifert, Glacier County Undersheriff presents the Lexipol – Police One Academy Annual Subscription Agreement. There is a Pro Rate cost of \$666.82 and Police One Academy Annual Subscription in the amount of \$1,447.80. He explains that this will allow the Glacier County Sheriff’s office access to virtual training videos which will help them stay up to date on their in-service training required yearly. There is a general discussion with the commissioners deciding to approve.
